



Artist Trevor Vickers' 50 years work showcased in new book

TREVOR Vickers does not title his artwork.

The Hamilton Hill resident likes people to view his paintings with a clear mind.

“It’s so I don’t lead people down a certain path,” he said.

“This way they can view it on their own terms.”

While this technique allows people to cast their eyes over his pieces with an uninhibited mind, it did make things a little tricky for the team compiling a 156-page book detailing his work.

Trevor Vickers – Untitled Painting, released tonight, celebrates his career in Melbourne, the UK and Perth, and showcases the hard-edged abstraction he has developed over five decades.

“It’s terrific to have photographic documentation of 50 years of work,” he said.

“Up until now I was probably the only person with a linear overview of things.”

The book was self-published by Art Collective WA and is the first in a series featuring career artists living and working in WA.

Art Collective WA director Felicity Johnston said there was a considerable amount of work in putting a book like this together, but the finished product made it all worth it.

“While there is a push for art dialogue to be featured through more immediate digital forums these days, we know that there is nothing like a printed book – something you can hold in your hands and refer to time and again – to tell a story,” she said.

“Our artist members all deserve to have books written about them and that’s what we are aiming to do.

“These are the visual artists that have shaped the cultural fabric of WA for 30 to 50 years – a significant and pertinent breadth of time.”

The book will be launched at Art Collective WA from 5pm-7pm tonight.

Art Collective is located at 115 Hay Street, Subiaco.

Mr Vickers’ *Catalan Series* will also be on display until May 14.
